

Woodhull Genealogy: The Woodhull Family in England and America

209. HARRIET WOODHULL, 6th generation, born September 15, 1790, was the eldest child of the Hon. John Woodhull, and his first wife, Phebe Worth.

She married, January 12, 1813, **Thomas Prince Conklin**.

He was born June 22, 1787, and died February 5, 1870.

She died August 4, 1874.

Children (Five):

- (1.) **Thomas Conklin**, born February 5, 1818; married, May 21, 1889, Hannah Vincent Cook Woodhull, (widow of William Woodhull). She was born August 1, 1819, and died October 4, 1899. He died February 6, 1891. They had one child:

William Woodhull Conklin, born September 16, 1862; married first, March 6, 1889, Ida Lillian Duryea. She was born September 27, 1869, and died May 30, 1901. He married second, March 18, 1903, Annie Harris Colley. She was born September 7, 1878.

- (2.) John Woodhull Conklin, born April 15, 1823, and died August 15, 1825.
- (3.) John Woodhull Conklin, (2nd.), born October 21, 1826, and died unmarried December 26, —.
- (4.) Henry Worth Conklin, born February 22, 1830; married, February 12, 1883, Nannie Wickham Horton. She was born January 20, 1839.
- (5.) Charles Conklin, born May 23, 1834; married first, December 28, 1864, Sarah Maria King. She was born April 22, 1841, and died November 10, 1885. They had one child:
Archie King Conklin, born July 5, 1866, and died November 20, 1888. He married second, March 2, 1887, Betsey Grant Hallock. She was born June 29, 1850. They had one child:
Charles Grant Conklin, born November 16, 1894.

218. WILLIAM HENRY WOODHULL, 6th generation, born in the year 1819, was the second son and third child of the Hon. John Woodhull and Ann Sell.

He married, February 1, 1842, Hannah, daughter of Luther Cook.

He died October 25, 1849.

They had no children.

209. HARRIET WOODHULL, m. Thomas Prince Conklin, Jan. 12, 1813. Thomas was born Jun. 22, 1787 and died Feb. 5, 1870. Thomas was the son of Major Thomas Conklin and Hannah Dimon Goldsmith. Hannah Dimon married first Major Thomas Conkling and second to Reverend Benjamin Goldsmith.

- (1) **Thomas Conklin**, b. Feb. 5, 1818, d. May 21, 1889, m. Mrs. Hannah Vincent "Cook" Woodhull, (widow of William Henry Woodhull). They had one child:
William Woodhull Conklin, m. first, March 6, 1889, Ida Lillian Duryea. She was born September 27, 1869, and died May 30, 1901. He married second, March 18, 1903, Annie Harris Colley. She was born September 7, 1878.
- (2) **John Woodhull Conklin**, b. Apr. 15, 1823, d. Aug. 15, 1825
- (3) **John Woodhull Conklin (2nd)**, b. Oct. 21, 1826, d. Dec. 26, 1894, unmarried
- (4) **Henry Worth Conklin**, b. Feb. 22, 1830, d. Aug. 26, 1900, m. Nancy 'Nannie' Wickham Horton
- (5) **Charles Conklin**, b. May 23, 1834, d. Aug. 17, 1912, m. 1st Sarah Maria King, m. 2nd Betsy Grant Hallock. Charles had 2 children; Archie King Conklin, by his first wife Sarah and Charles Grant Conklin by his second wife Betsy

218. WILLIAM HENRY WOODHULL, m. Hannah Vincent Cook, Feb. 1, 1842. Hannah was the daughter of Luther Cook and Mary Hoctor of Westhampton, New York. Hannah was born Aug. 1, 1819 and died Oct. 4, 1899. William and Hannah had no children. William was a farmer and he died at Franklinville, Long Island. Hannah remarried (about 1861) after William's death to Thomas Conklin and they had one child; William Woodhull Conklin. Thomas was the son of Thomas Prince Conklin and Harriet Woodhull. Thomas was born Feb. 5, 1818 and died May 21, 1889 at Jamesport, Suffolk, New York. In Probate Court, Letters of Administration were granted to Hannah V. Conklin, wife, and William W. Conklin, son, on June 17, 1889. We do not know where Thomas or Hannah Conklin were buried.

John Conklin Dead.

On Thursday last, Greenpoint lost one of its oldest and best known residents in the death of John Conklin, who died suddenly of apoplexy. Mr. Conklin had been employed for some years past in the Navy Yard as a carpenter, and resided with his family at 117 Calyer street. The funeral services were held on Saturday evening last at the Noble Street Baptist Church, the Rev. Jessup Sholler preaching the funeral discourse. The interment occurred yesterday in Cypress Hills Cemetery.
